GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The quantity of work can be increased / decreased as per site requirement up to +/- 5%.
2. The work shall be done from 9.00 AM to 5.00 PM during day shift only.
3. The contractor will execute the work to the entire satisfaction of Engineer-in-Charge of the work.
4. The dispute if any will be brought to the notice of RE/DPH Divn., BBMB (PW) Slapper. The decision of SE/DPH Circle, BBMB (PW) Slapper will be final.
5. The Engineer-in-charge reserve the right to order in writing from time to time during progress of the work removed and re-execution of any work, which is not in the opinion of the Engineer-in-charge, in accordance with the specifications.
6. **T&P:** All the T&P to be used for execution of the work shall be arranged by the contractor.
7. The register progress of the work of each day shall be maintained by the contractor, which will have to be shown to the Engineer-in-charge whenever required and similar register will also be maintained by the JE/in charge.
8. Presence of contractor's representative and supervisor at site to control the progress of the work and labour, the contractor will arrange his representatives for all the time during the course of work so that he may be contacted any time, as and when required.
9. **Labour and Wages:**
 - a) The contractor will execute the work as per the instruction laid down under the contractor labour ACT-1970, Labour Law Act, 1998. Minimum wages Act-1948 & child labour Act-1986. Contractor may ensure to make payment to his worker through their bank account for better accountability.
 - b) It will be duty of the contractor to arrange sufficient labour in the interest of work & fix wages as their nature of work and qualification as per law.
 - c) Wages due to every worker shall be paid to him directly by the contractor. The contractor shall be required to submit to Engineer-in-charge on 10th of every month a return on a prescribed Performa for payment of the wages under fair wages Act.
 - d) The Engineer-in-Charge will record a certificate on the bill indicating the extend if any to the fault has been committed & the amount of the recoveries in respect of the cost of commission & omission of the labourers that the necessary deduction from the contractor bill has been made & wages and deduction from the contractor bill has been made the wages& other deduction paid to the labour
 - i) Stocking of material as per requirement as well as availability of the same shall be the responsibility of the contractor .The watch & ward of

the material as well as T&P will be the responsibility of the contractor at his own expenses for which no extra payment will be made.

- ii) **Damage to work /Deptt. By the Contractor:** If any damage to any property to the BBMB in which the work is to be done occurs during the courses of work which may be due to mismanagement, poor planning bad workmanship on the contractors part, contractor will be held personally responsible for the same and if will be recoverable from the contractor as pert the decision of SE/DPH Circle, BBMB (PW) Slapper.
- iii) **Extension of Time limit:** if any stage the courses of the work due to unavoidable circumstances beyond the control of control of contractor, the contractor will apply black and white to the RE/DPH Slapper indicating all the reasons in detail due to which extension is needed for approval of extension of time limit. After going through the reasons mentioned hereof, may grant extension as deemed fit, for further continuation of work.
- iv) **Non-compliance of instruction, suspension of work thereof:** If at any stage it is found that the contractor is not working as per the instruction of Engineer-in Chief, or the progress of work is not up to the satisfaction of the Engineer-in-Chief or any specific instructions relating the right to suspend the work partly or as a whole as deemed fit.
- v) **Arbitration:** if at any time any question dispute of difference whatsoever shall arise between Deptt. And question dispute upon or in relation to or connection with the contract either partly may forthwith give to the other notice in writing of the existence of such question, dispute or difference and the same shall be referred to the Award of the sole arbitrator to be nominated by the concerned CE of the BBMB not below the rank of Director/SEs of the Deptt. And the decision of arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.
The provisions of Indian Arbitration & Compilation Act-1996 and the rules there under and any statutory amendment/modification for re-enactment thereof for the time being in force shall be deemed to apply to and be incorporated in the contract.
Such a notice of the existence of any question, dispute or difference in connection with contract shall be served by either party within 180 days of the exigency failing which all rights and claims under this contract shall be deemed to have been forfeited and absolutely barred.
The work under the contract shall, if reasonably possible continued during the arbitration proceeding and no payment due or payable by the Deptt. Shall be withheld on Account of such proceedings.
- vi) **Negligence in work :**if the contractor neglects to execute the work with due diligence and expedition refuse or neglect to comply with any reasonable orders given in writing by the BBMB, in connection with the work order or shall contravene the provision of the work Order the Deptt. May give 21 days' notice in writing to the contractor to make good the failure, neglect of contravention complained of and should the contract fail to comply with the notice within a reasonable time from the date of service thereof in case of failure, neglect of contravention capable of being made good, within that time of otherwise within such

time as may be reasonable necessary for making if good then and in such case the Deptt. Shall be at liberty to take the work wholly or partly out of the hands of the contractor and re-contract at reasonable price with any person. In such an event it shall be lawful for the deptt. To retain any such balance, which may otherwise be due by him to the contractor or any account including the amount of Earnest money and apply same towards the execution of the whole of balance of the work, so reconstructed as aforesaid. If no such balance is due by the deptt. To the contractor or if due is not sufficient to recover the amount thus recoverable from the Contractor and it shall be lawful for the deptt. To recover the whole or balance of the amount from the contractor by action of law.

- vii) **Action and compensation payable tin case of bad work:** If it appear so the Engineer-in Chief or his subordinate in charge of the work that any work has been executed with unsound, imperfect or unskillful workmanship or with material art any inferior description or that any articles of material provided by the contractor for the execution of work or unsound or of a quality inferior to that contractor or otherwise not in accordance with the contract. The contractor shall no demand in writing from the EngineerOin-Charge specifying the work materials or articles complained for notwithstanding that the same have been inadvertently passed, certified and paid for, forthwith rectify or remove and reconstruct the work As specified in whole or in part as the case may require or as the case may be remove the materials or articles so specified and provide other proper and suitable material ort articles at his own proper charge and cost. In the event of his failing to do so within a period to be specified by the Engineer-in-Charge, the contractor shall be liable to pay compensation @ 1% of the estimated amount for every week not exceeding 10 weeks, while his failure to do so shall continue and in the case of such failure the Engineer-in-Charge may rectify or remove and execute the work of remove and replace with others the material or the articles complained of , as the case may be at the risk and expenses , in all respect of the contractor.
- viii) **Accident safety measure:** In case of any accident during execution of work, the contractor shall be held fully responsible and no compensation will be given by the Deptt. & the contractor should take required safety measures during execution of work at his cost.
- ix) The item/work if any required to be done at site addition to the job covered under schedule quantities shall be paid on the basis of rates of Pb. CSR-2010 plus quoted premium.
- x) **Safety Code** : General contractor shall adhere to safety construction practice & guard against hazardous & unsafe working condition shall comply with honor safety rules as set forth herein prior to start of construction, contractor will be furnished copies owner "**Safety Code**" for information & guidance, if it has been prepared.
- xi) **Safety regulation** : In interest of all labour directly or indirectly employee in the work for performance of contractor part of this agreement the contractor shall has his own expenses arranging for all

the safety provision as per safety code of Punjab PWD code act as applicable.

xii) **First AID & Industrial injuries :**

- a) Contractor shall maintain first aid facility for its employees.
- b) Contractor shall make outside arrangement for ambulance service & for treatment of industrial injuries name of those providing these services shall be furnish to owner prior to start of construction & their telephone number shall be prominently be furnish to owner.
- c) All critical industrial injuries shall be reported promptly to owner & a copy of contractor report covering each personal injury required the attention of physician shall be furnished to owner.

- 10) **Indemnity & insurance:** The contractor shall indemnity & keep to indemnity the owner against all losses & claim for injuries & damage to any person of any person or any property what so ever may arise out of or in consequence the construction & maintenance of work against all demands, proceeding demand cost charges & expenses what even so ever in respect of or in relation therein.
- 11) The contractor shall obtain at his expenses any insurance policy in the joint name of the owner & the contractor covering the following risks & lodge the policy with the employees.
- 12). No work beyond the provision of work order be carried out without prior approval, if any violation no payment will be made to this extra work.
- 13). In the event of a breach of contract in any manner , the security deposit shall be forfeited & adjusted against the claim of the Board on the contractor for any damaged or for any loss sustained by the Board on account of such breach.

ANNEXURE-B

COMMERCIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. *The reputed class contractor registered with State/ Central P.W.D. and MES & other Public sector/Enterprises who has been the experience. And obtained License by the Licensing Officer under **Contract Labour Act-1970**.*
2. *The Co-operative societies must also produce / attached a certificate duly numbered and signed by the Registered Co-operative society to show that:-
i) **The Society is in existence and holds good reputation and there is no complaint against it.***
3. *Conditional on line tenders shall be not be accepted.*
4. *If it happens to be holiday on the day of opening of tenders, the same shall be opened on next day/date.*
5. *Security deposit will be deducted from the running bill/final bill at the rate of 10% of the gross value of work done from time to time .No interest shall be payable to the contractor on the amount of security deposit. & the same shall be refunded after a year from the date of completion of work.*
6. *In the event of the default on the part of contractor in the faithful execution, security deposit shall be forfeited by the order of the contracting agency under intimation to other SE's/CE's and Secretary/ Board. The forfeiture of security deposit shall be without prejudice to any other rights rising or accruing to the board under relevant provision of the contract, line penalty / damage for delay in delivery or *risk in execution of work including suspension of business dealing with board for a specific period.**
7. *Measurement and payment of work shall be regulated as per **PWD Specifications**, 100% payment will be released after completion and measurement of the work. The payment will be made through cheque.*
8. ***As per Govt. of India notification dated 19.05.2015 under RCM, the firm will deposit 50% service tax as per applicable on the labour portion with Central Excise Department & submit the proof to BBMB. Balance 50% service tax shall be deposited by BBMB at prevalent rates.***
9. *The dispute if any should be brought to the notice of Resident Engineer, DPH BBMB (PW), Slapper and Dy. Chief Engineer / Superintending Engineer , DPH Circle BBMB PW), Slapper. Decision of Dy. Chief Engineer /Superintending Engineer, DPH on any dispute will be final.*
10. *The item / work if any required to be done at site in addition to the job covered under schedule of quantities shall be paid on the basis of rates of Pb. CSR -2010 plus prevailing premium at the time of opening the tenders.*
11. *The tender should be valid for 120 days only from the date of opening of the tender.*
12. *The bidder(s) has /have to be quoted unit rate in figure/word only.*
13. *The work shall be completed within 45 days from the date of receipt of work order. Before start of the work, contractor will provide his work program accordingly.*
14. *The contractor has to execute the contract deed in prescribed format before the start of work.*
15. *The work shall be done in the working hours i.e. 9 AM to 5 PM.*
16. *The bidder may inspect the site and satisfy himself on all matters before submission of tender.*
17. *All the material / T&P required for execution of work shall be arranged by the contractor. It will be the duty of contractor to arrange sufficient skilled labour in the interest of work and fix*

- their wages as per their nature of work and qualification as per Labour law. The department will not interfere in any way in case if any dispute arises between them during the course of work.
18. **The material to be used shall be strictly as per I.S Specifications /relevant Indian standard (Latest amended). Material to be used for various works may be got checked / approved from the Engineer-in-Charge before executing the work.**
 19. Acceptance of tender is subject to the approval of the competent authority who does not bind himself to approve or accept the lowest tender and reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
 20. Income tax and any other tax if legally payable on the gross value of the work done will be deducted from the contractor's bill as per prevalent rates.
 21. In case the water is used from BBMB sources then water charges. $\frac{1}{2}\%$ on the amount of items for which water is used shall be deducted from the contractor's bills.
 22. **Penalty**: If the contractor fails to abide by the provision of clause completion period, he shall be liable to pay $\frac{1}{2}\%$ per week or part thereof the contract value of such work as has not been completed within the completion period and shall not exceed 10% of contract value of work whichever is higher.
 23. The tender accepting authority without prejudice to any other right shall cancel the contract if the contractor assigns, transfer, sublets or attempts to assign transfer or sublet, any portion of the work without the prior approval of accepting officer.
 24. The work will be done as per P.W.D. specification.
 25. All the provision of BBMB purchase procedure 2014 which are available at BBMB website (www.bbmb.nic.in) will be applicable.
